

# PRIVACY STATEMENT

Dear Sirs,

We inform you that the D.lgs. n.196 of 30<sup>th</sup> June 2003 ("The privacy code") establishes a protection for people and other subjects as far as the processing of personal data is concerned.

According to the law, the processing must be characterized by honesty, legality, transparency and privacy.

According to Article 13 of D.lgs. n.196/2003, we provide you with the following information:

1. Your data will be used to inform you about the activities organized by the Hotel;
2. The processing will be carried out by a computerized system;
3. Some data are optional but, in case of refusal, this might cause the relationship to end;
4. The data will be not communicated to other subjects;
5. The person in charge of the processing is Mr. Giorgio Pristeri;
6. At any time you can make use of your rights toward the person in charge, according to Article 7 of D.lgs. 196/2003: Legislative Decree n.196/2003, Art. 7 – Right of access to personal data and other rights:
  1. The interested parties have the right to obtain confirmation of the existence of data about them (even if they are not yet registered) and a communication thereof.
  2. The interested parties have the right to obtain information about:
    - a. the origin of the personal data;
    - b. the aim and the methods of the processing;
    - c. the features of the computerized system (when this kind of processing is used);
    - d. the identifying data of the owner, the persons in charge and the representative appointed according to the Article 5, paragraph 2;
    - e. the subjects or categories of subjects their personal data may be communicated to, as representatives, people in charge or delegates;

3. The interested parties have the right to obtain:
  - a. an updating, a correction or – if interested – an integration of the data;
  - b. the cancellation, the conversion into anonymous form or the stoppage of the personal data if processed breaking the law, including the data whose keeping is not necessary for the aims for which they have been collected or dealt with.
  - c. a declaration that the operations at points a) and b) have been reported, also as far as their content is concerned, to those to whom the data have been communicated or transmitted, except when such report is impossible to carry out or implies costs which are evidently exorbitant in comparison with the protected rights.
4. The interested parties have the right to object:
  - a. for legitimate reasons, to the processing of their personal data, even when they are relevant to the aim of their collection;
  - b. to the processing of their personal data, when aimed at sending advertisements or commercial information or carrying out marketing research.
